## Taleblank launches with a novel approach to RPG scheduling

MELBOURNE, Australia – After months in early access, Taleblank is now available worldwide.

The online, text-based, and asynchronous role-playing game offers busy players escapist thrills without requiring large time commitments or mutual availability.

The game was designed and built by a parent of two young children, who was struggling to fit traditional role-playing gaming into his busy new life.

"Taleblank has allowed my group to continue playing even when we cannot schedule a traditional session of Dungeons & Dragons."

In Taleblank, players take their turn at their own pace and at a time that's convenient for them.

This makes it perfect for players with busy schedules or who are in different time zones, who struggle to find a time to play that works for everybody.

Taleblank is an innovative mix of a role-playing game, fill-in-the-blanks, and writing a novel.

With no graphics and a heavy focus on text – both reading and writing – Taleblank may not be to everyone's taste.

Realising that, the developers let you try the game for free.

For those who want to keep playing, there is a one-time cost of \$9.99 per adventure.

Feedback from the early access program has been overwhelmingly positive, with one player commenting: "I'm impressed by how the system manages to provide just the right amount of structure for us to know how to move forward, while at the same time leaving a lot of room for us to be creative and take the story in the direction we want to."

Taleblank currently features two settings, a medieval city and a modern-day high school, with more settings coming soon.

Each setting has its own scenarios, which eliminate the need for the Game Master to prepare ahead of time.
